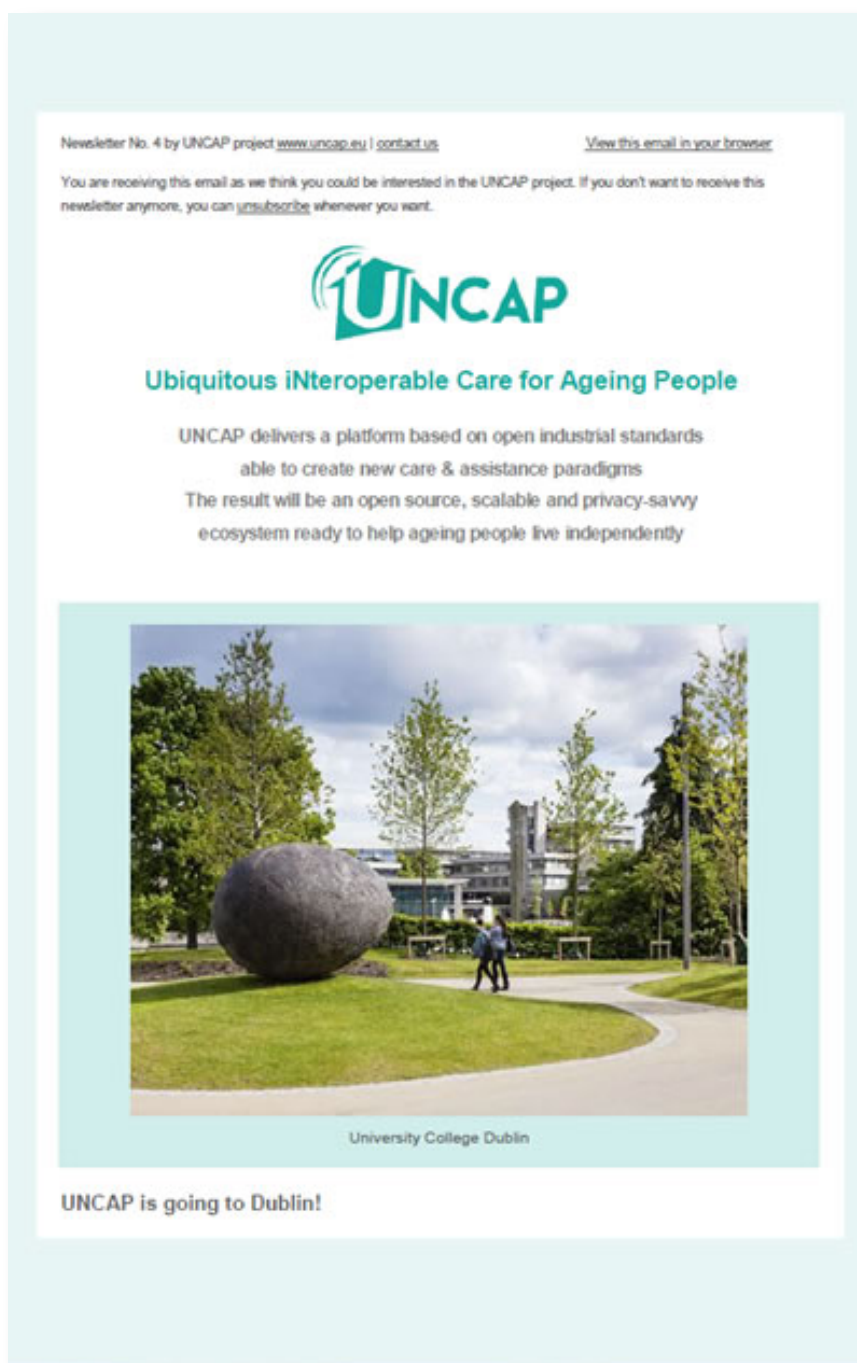


Figure 4: UNCAP in Dublin newsletter.

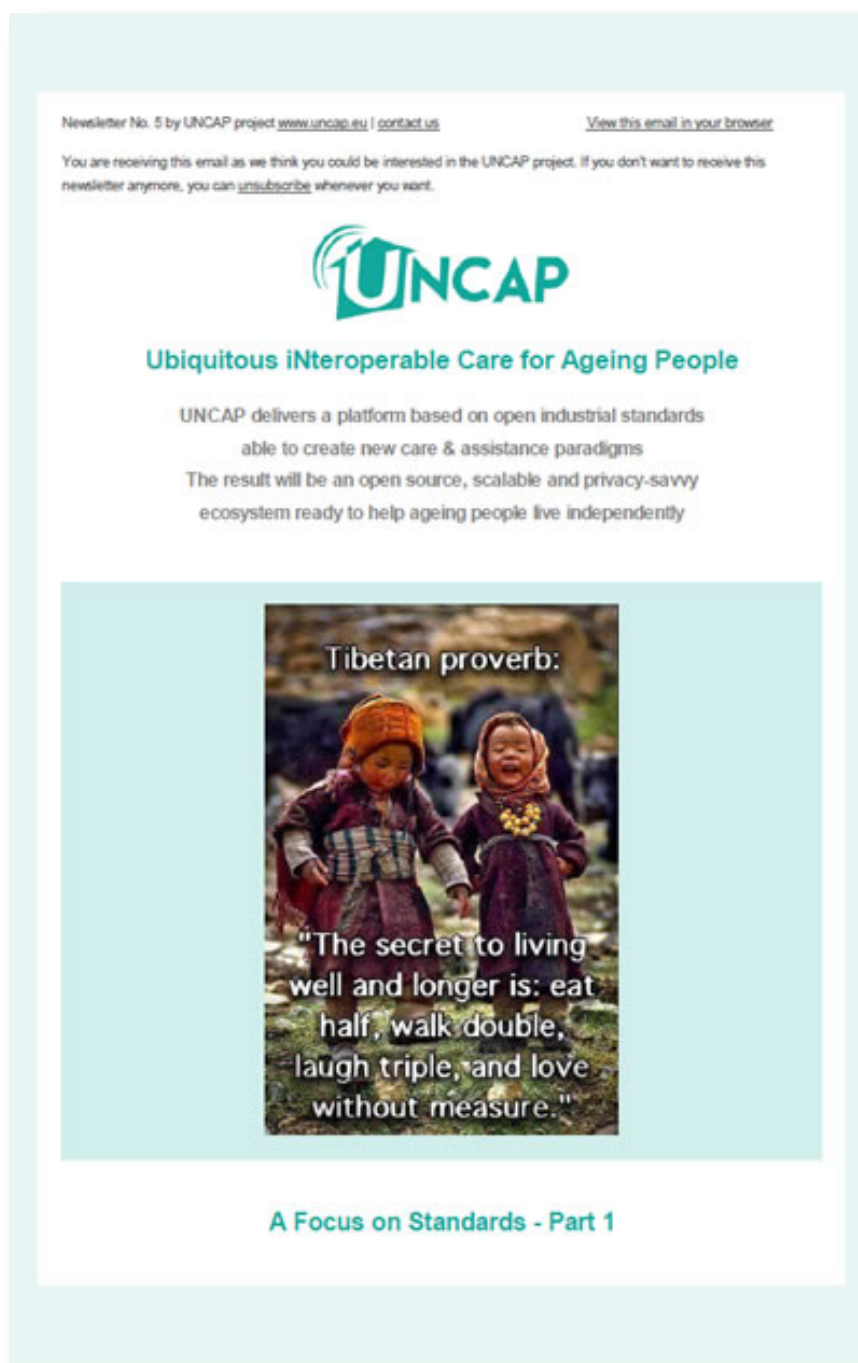


Figure 5: Focus on standards part 1 newsletter.

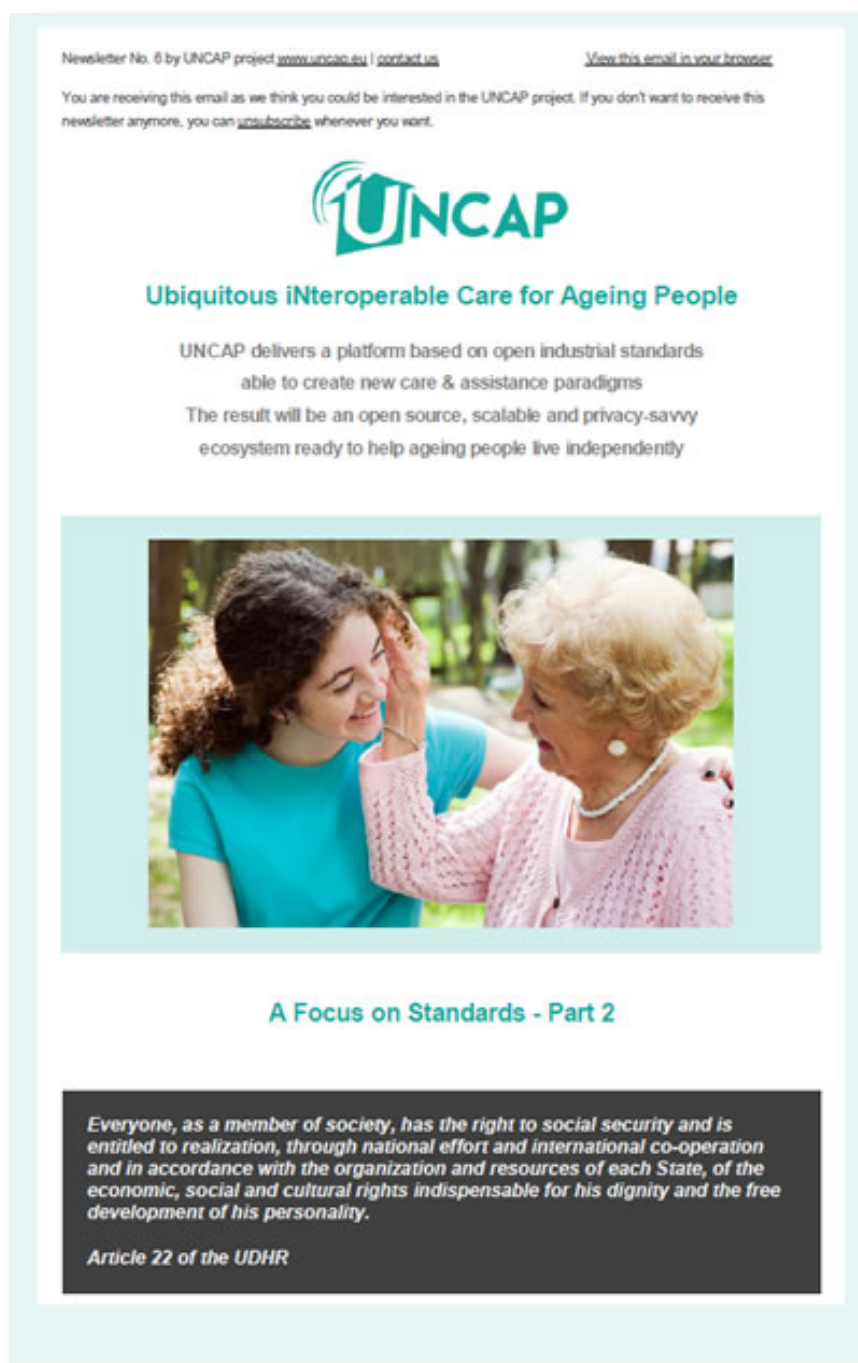


Figure 6: Focus on standards part 2 newsletter.

8.1.1.1. Past events

The international conference Interoperable and Location-Based Healthcare Services For Citizens was held on 13 January 2015 in Trento, Italy. There were over 50 attendees at this event.

Within this conference, new ICT technologies for interoperability of devices and location have been presented and discussed by a gathering of international experts presenting the potential applications in healthcare of these innovative technologies that will become central in the coming years for their ability to offer new responses and new services for the health of citizens.

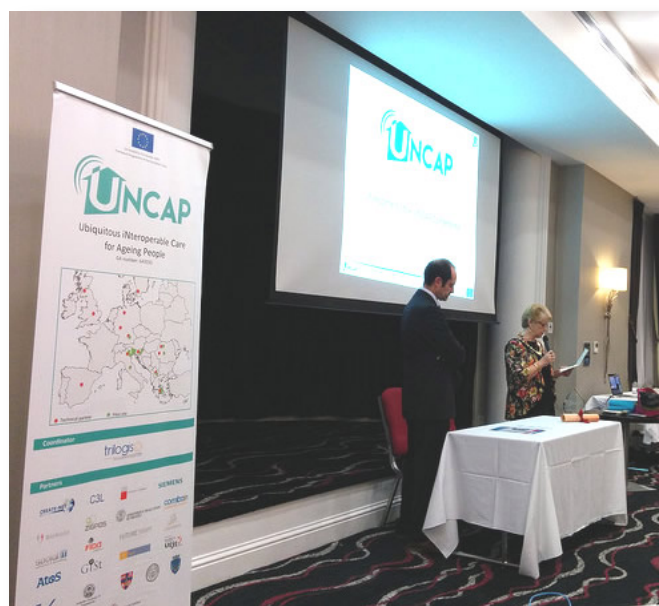


Figure 9: The Lord Mayor of Nottingham opens the UNCAP conference.

During the conference, the **UNCAP Challenge** has been held. This year, the first prize has been awarded to Trilogis for **HAle (Home Assisted Living for Elderly)**, a hardware and software solution capable of monitoring elderly people living in nursing homes or their home. While the second prize has been awarded to **Nelumbox**, a cooling box for cold chain solutions.

8.1.1.2. Events organised during 2016

Annual Conference and exhibition 2016 – Dublin, Ireland

A newsletter, “The Dublin Flyer” was created to publicize and promote the second annual conference and exhibition held in University College Dublin, Ireland and a “media pack” was sent to interested parties, including newspapers, television and radio stations.

The event ran concurrently with the OGC e-health summit and members of the consortium, Trilogis and C3L presented at the summit. Attendees included OGC Health DWG participants, OGC members, other interested stakeholders, including 40 participants. Activities included 4 panels, 1 survey round, and the UNCAP technology showcase.

OGC is an industry standards organization with an active e-health DWIG (Domain Working Group). C3L’s presentation on dignity was both thought provoking and insightful and was well received by the audience.

The Vice Chair of Alzheimer’s Ireland graciously opened the event.

Many consortium members showcased at the event, bringing refined and developing technologies. However, the UNCAP challenge, judged independently by the Vice Chair of Alzheimer’s Ireland awarded the trophy to Christl Lauterbach, Managing Director of FUTURESHAPE, the creator of SensFloor. SensFloor, a large-area sensor system, is based on a textile underlay with a thickness of 2 mm, only. The sensor system has four integrated radio modules and 32 proximity sensors per square meter. Whenever a person walks across the floor, sensor signals are sent to a control unit and different



types of events are identified: The sensor system distinguishes between a person standing or laying on the floor and determines the direction and the velocity of the movement. Static signal detection and self-test capability are important features for security applications.

8.1.1.3. Future events

Annual Conference and exhibition 2017 – Paris, France

Following a Doodle poll among the consortium partners, it was decided to hold the final UNCAP exhibition in Paris.

There is a wonderful opportunity to showcase the UNCAP suite of technologies at the Silver Economy Expo (SEE). The SEE will give the project and its partners the perfect opportunity to exhibit and discuss their new innovations and developments with the major players in the 'Silver Economy sector'.

GiStandards representative, Chris Whitmarsh, attended the 2016 show on behalf of the project and has negotiated advantageous rates for UNCAP exhibitors. This year's show saw 50 exhibitors currently marketing their products into this lucrative sector and a total in excess of 2,500 qualified business visitors.

Running parallel with the expo is a conference and topics include:

- Are towns and regions adapted to senior citizens' needs?
- Tomorrow, will humans live to 150 years or more?
- Dare to innovate to provide better support for families,
- Planning for the elderly: the new solutions to help find a nursing home rapidly,
- Dare to think home automation to adapt private homes to the loss of autonomy.

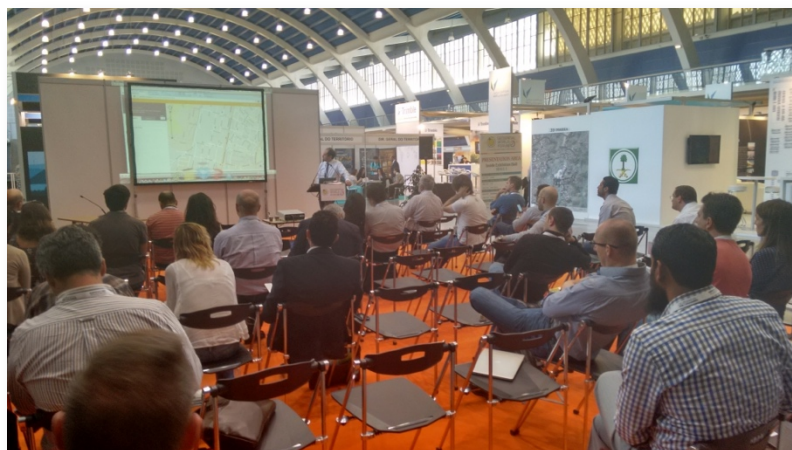


Figure 14: Foss4G Como 2015.
